AMZA - Chapter Facilitator/Leader (Pretoria South, West and North)

ROLE DESCRIPTION

AMZA - Chapter Facilitator/Leaders are required to co-lead and co-facilitate the 2 hr Authentic Manhood Sessions at a designated chapter location for 1 day per week. He will always be paired up with another Chapter Facilitator/Leader. He will be provided with the necessary training equipment, materials and method statement.

Basic Role requirements are:

- Ensure venue is prepared and ready to receive men 30 min in advance (usually 18h30 on Wednesdays)
- Ensure that enough training guides and refreshments are ready
- Ensure that necessary audio visual equipment is tested and ready
- Ensure that the correct video content is loaded and ready
- Ensure that Attendance register is ready and completed at the beginning of each session.
- Welcome men to the session
- Facilitate the delivery of the audio-visual content
- · Facilitate the post-video discussion and note taking
- Ensure all materials, equipment and venue is packed up neatly and returned

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

- Must have a passion to serve other men in the pursuit of Authentic Manhood principles.
- Must be willing to commit to a 1 year long agreement.
- Must be able to devote at least 3 hours/week to the cause
- Must have completed volumes 1 to 3 of "33 The Series" on Authentic Manhood
- Must provide evidence of basic public speaking and facilitation.
- Must reside in the appropriate Chapter location.
